

There is also a long distance between her neck and the implants, as they seem to be sitting unnaturally low."



FILLER UP

Courtney Cox

Having said in the past that she is "very open in terms of prolonging the inevitable" and "a big laser believer," the actress, 50, has also copped to using Botox "very sparingly ... I don't have a problem with any of that stuff. If it makes you feel better about yourself and it's done properly, then fine." Zacharia suspects lip filler and cheek filler, and wonders if she may have also had upper-eye surgery to remove excess skin.



Chelsea Handler

The comedian and talk-show host, 39, "does look puffy around the face and this could be the result of far too much filler," Zacharia suggests. "Or she could have had fat transfer to the face. This is where liposuction is performed on a part of the body and the fat then put into the face. It is especially prominent in her cheeks."



LeAnn Rimes

The country crooner, 32, sued her former dentist in 2013 over veneers and crowns that led to chronic dental troubles, but Zacharia suspects she has had other appearance-altering work. "LeAnn looks very puffy in the upper eye area, as though she might need a good rest," he says. "She is puffy in the cheeks also, and this is probably due to cheek filler. The reason filler in the cheeks is popular is because it gives the skin a bit of a lift in that area of the face." ■

"I get Botox regularly and I'm very happy to talk about why," says the singer and actress, 46, who claims the procedure helps combat debilitating migraines. "Every six months, five shots right here [motions across her eyebrows]. I'm thankful for it."

Zacharia approves: "A beautiful smile ... I think she looks very natural."
